

Markus C. KERBER

Prof. Dr. Markus C. Kerber is professor of public finance and political economy at the Technology University Berlin. He was visiting professor of defense economics at Sciences Po Paris. As for 2014 he will teach this topic at University Paris II. From 1999 - 2001 he was a visiting lecturer at the Chief of Staff Bundeswehr Academy. Kerber is a lawyer shuffling between Berlin, Paris, Brussels and London. His activities also included senior positions in investment banks in London and Paris. Kerber published numerous articles on public finance, corporate finance, antitrust law and European law. Under his responsibility, several complaints against the Euro rescue mechanisms (EFSF, ESM, OMT) have been initiated in the German Constitutional Court as well as in the European Court of Justice. He is the founder of the think tank “Europolis” based in Berlin, specialised in monetary and fiscal policy, which already produced numerous publications not only in German, but also French and English¹.
